## **HANDBOOKS**

## **SHARES AND STORE NIGHT**

Clubbers earn Cubbie shares that can be spent at the Cubbie store.

This store is opened during designated club nights.

## **AWARDS**

No charge is made for their patches each time they complete a section or path. However, if a Clubber loses a patch, he or she will have to pay \$1.00 for a replacement patch.

## **SUNDAY SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AWARD**

Clubbers may earn two awards by regularly attending the Sunday school or church of their parent's choice. The Clubbers are only allowed two unexcused absences to earn a Sunday school patch each term.

## **CLASS ATTENDANCE**

Clubbers may earn two awards by regularly attending Cubbies class. The Clubbers are only allowed two unexcused absences to earn a class attendance patch each term.

**COMPLETED HANDBOOK AWARD** At the end of the Awana year, the Clubbers are rewarded a 1<sup>st</sup> Cubbie bear award or a 2<sup>nd</sup> book ribbon award.

### **WHO CAN ATTEND**

Children who are two years before Kindergarten age can start Cubbies.

### **CLUB TIME**

Our clubs will meet regularly every Friday, starting at 7:30 PM in the Gym and ending at about 9:00 PM in Room 102. Please be on time when dropping off and picking up your child.

### **REGISTRATION AND DUES**

"It cost an average of \$110 to cover all the expenses per child for an Awana year. To help with the cost recovery, please give \$30 per child at the time of registration." We also ask for your partnership in faith offering and prayer for the needs of the AWANA program.

### **CUBBIES ENTRANCE BOOKLET**

All Cubbies will begin their club work with an entrance booklet at the beginning of the year. The Clubber will then be eligible to receive the handbook and purchase a Cubbie vest. The Clubber will receive their handbook patch after the two trail sections are completed.

### **UNIFORM**

The cost of the uniform for the Cubbies is **\$15.00**.

The Cubbies' vest is needed to display the awards the Clubber earns, and must be worn to all club activities unless otherwise instructed.
