## **Handbooks**

There is a handbook for each of the Four years a clubber can be in T&T. **Everyone begins in the *Start Zone*.**

- Third-graders coming up from Sparks
- Third-, fourth-, fifth- and sixth-graders that have never attended Awana.
- Fourth-, fifth- and sixth-graders making the transition to T&T from Pals, Chums, Guards or Pioneers.



**Please note:** Third-graders can only complete the Book One in one club year, Fourth-graders can complete both the Book One and Two in one club year, Fifth-graders can complete the Book One, Two, and Three in one club year, and finally Sixth-graders can complete all the T&T Clubbers handbooks in one club year.

There is no charge is made for a handbook. However, if a T&T Clubber loses a handbook, he or she will have to pay \$5.00 for a replacement.

## **Stores**

Clubber earns AWANA shares that can be spent at the AWANA store. This store is opened during designated club nights.

## **Awards**

No charge is made for their **award badge** and **achievement seals** for their badge each time they complete a Discovery or Challenge. However, if a T&T Clubber loses an awards badge, he or she will have to pay \$5.00 for a replacement badge, and \$1.00 for a replacement achievement seal.



**Sunday School Attendance Award:** T&T Clubbers may earn two awards by regularly attending the Sunday school or church of their parent's choice.

**Handbook Awards:** After completing the each book has a separate award badge. Clubbers will receive an achievement seal for their badge each time they complete a Discovery or Challenge T&T Clubbers uniform. Only T&T Clubbers in uniform are eligible to receive their awards.

**Completed Handbook Award:** At the end of the Awana year, the T&T Clubbers are rewarded 1<sup>st</sup> book award **ribbon**. The 2<sup>nd</sup> book award is called the "**Excellence**", a 3<sup>rd</sup> book award is the 3<sup>rd</sup> book "**Plaque**", and a clubber receives a "**Timothy Award**" after completing four books.

*Parents: Please read the instructions in your child's handbook and familiarize yourself with their contents. Your cheerful assistance will make all the difference to your child.*

### **T&T Clubbers Purpose**

To help boys and girls benefit spiritually, mentally, physically, and emotionally from each weekly T&T Clubbers meeting.
